Training of Trainers on sustainability standards compliance targets experts and practitioners in the Armenian textile and apparel sector and aims to equip them with the practical knowledge on responsible sourcing, sustainability standards and ESG frameworks, social and labour compliance, sustainability-related regulations in the EU and elsewhere (including corporate sustainability due diligence), resource efficiency and circular economy principles in the textile and apparel sector.

The training will also prepare the participants to support SMEs in the textile and apparel sector on compliance with sustainability standards using ITC Standards Map tool and proven methodological approach.
